CROSS COUNTRY PRACTICE & MEET



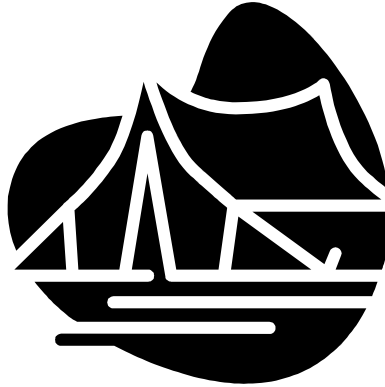

From the Principal’s Desk

The second “R” at Immanuel is responsibility. You may not find a “responsibility” grade on your child’s report card, but teaching responsibility is important at Immanuel. As is developmentally appropriate, children are taught to take responsibility for themselves. Students are taught to use an assignment notebook to help keep track of tasks as well as spelling words and memory work. Students are assigned homework regularly. Homework not only reinforces learning in the classroom but teaches responsibility. Completing and turning in homework on time is a critical lesson in responsibility. As part of the Immanuel family, students also learn responsibility through classroom jobs and picking up after themselves in the classroom.

How can you support responsibility at home?

1. Ask your child to see his/her assignment notebook regularly. Discuss the information included. Help him to prioritize and schedule appropriately.
2. Make homework important. Schedule a specific time and place for homework. If there is no assignment, use that time to study spelling or memory work. Help your child to organize himself the night before. Assignments should be placed in the backpack to assure they can be turned in on time.
3. Get students to school on time. School starts at 8:00 a.m. That means that jackets should be hung up, backpacks unpacked, and students are in their seats ready to learn.
4. Give your child chores at home. Even Pre-Kindergarteners can do chores. Some ideas for chores are: picking up toys, setting/clearing the table, taking out the trash, or making beds. As they get older students may make their own lunches, do dishes, feed/clean up after their pets, or dust. The ideas are endless. I am not promoting child labor, but I do promote allowing your child to be a contributing member of the family.

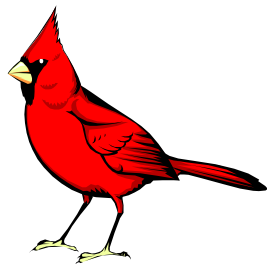
