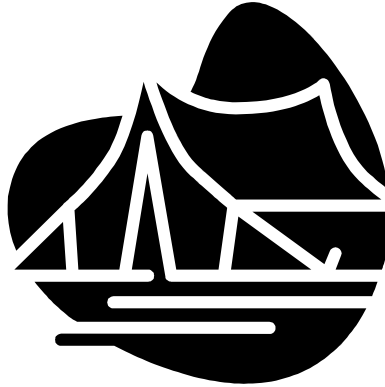

From the Principal’s Desk

The third “R” is reading. We have three main ways of taking in information. We can take in information with our eyes as we observe those things that go on in the world around us. Another way to take information is with our ears as we hear the sounds of our world and the voices that talk to us. A third way of taking in information is reading. Reading can give us a variety of information on a variety of topics. Reading can confirm ideas we already have or expose us to ideas that we never dreamed. Reading can take us to times and places we have never been and introduce us to people we have never met.

In school, reading is fundamental. In PreK-4, we begin to learn the sounds that letters make. By kindergarten, we begin to combine those letter sounds and begin to recognize words. Through the primary grades we continue work on phonics and decoding strategies as we develop a broader vocabulary. Later, we work on expanding vocabulary and developing strategies to help gain a better understanding of what we read. We become more dependent on reading as a source of information.

The following list of tips is provided as suggestions for helping your child with reading:

- Read everyday
- Read with and to your child
- Set a purpose for reading
- Do partner journaling (an ongoing conversation regarding reading)
- Utilize travel time talk (book discussion during carpool)
- Provide books on tape for reluctant readers
- Have celebrations tied to the reading
- Visit local library
- Participate in summer reading programs
- Participate in reading incentive programs
- Attend author visits at local bookstores
- Provide support for content area text

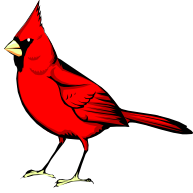
