From the Principal’s Desk

Writing is the fourth “R.” Writing is a crucial means of communicating. It is more than the proper formation of the letters of the alphabet. It is the very idea of communicating meaning from one individual to another. Writing is not only important during the school years but is also a critical life skill.

How can you support writing at home? First, encourage your child to slow down and use neat penmanship. If it is worth writing, it is worth writing well! Find authentic opportunities for your child to write. Young students can make grocery lists, write thank you notes for gifts, write to a pen pal or family member, or keep a journal/diary. Children tend to be more motivated when they are writing for a purpose. An activity that many children enjoy is a two-way journal. The child writes down thoughts and ideas in a journal. He gives it to a parent or other adult to read and respond. The adult returns the journal to the child, and the process continues. This journaling can be rewarding to both child and adult.

Just as with other skills, the more your child writes the better he will write. Practice really does make perfect (or closer to it)!

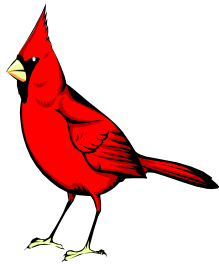
