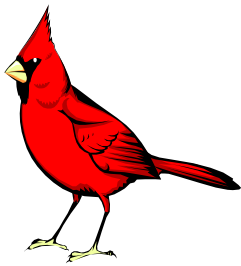
From the Principal’s Desk

Your personalized re-registration form for 2010-2012 will be sent home with your child(ren) today with PK and Kindergarten. All other grades will be mailed home. At this time, registration is open to current Immanuel families only. It is important to register and to pay the \$100 enrollment fee promptly to assure space in the appropriate class. Registration will not be considered complete without the enrollment fee. Registration for 4 year old pre-kindergarten and kindergarten will be open to the public beginning February 9th. Open House and general registration for grades 1-8 will begin on March 14th.

You will notice that the re-enrollment form is a SMART TUITION form. The form is pre-printed with all of your family information. Review the form. If you have no changes, send the form along with your check for \$100 back to the school office. If you have changes, please indicate the changes on the form.
