IMPORTANT REMINDER (repeat)

Students in kindergarten, second grade and sixth grade must have a dental examination form on file before May 15th. This is a mandatory state law and we will be reporting to the government on the 16th for those students that are non-compliant. If a dental exam is not completed, there is a waiver portion that must be filled out and returned to the school office as soon as possible. According to state law, report cards can be held back until a form is received. If you have any questions, call the school office. Dental forms were mailed to you before school began in July. A second form was sent home with the students that are not in compliance as of today's date.

Attention All Parents

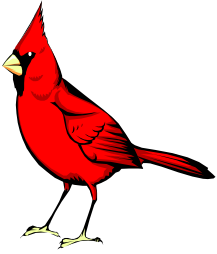
